



CODE OF CONDUCT

Montclair Film and Montclair Film Cinemas strive to create a welcoming space for all communities that gather here. We invite everyone to join us in fostering a community of respect, kindness, and inclusion.

We are committed to a culture of true hospitality and strive to anticipate and meet the needs of all our patrons with a generous and friendly spirit. Mutual respect and trust are foundational to a healthy community. Montclair Film stands firmly against racism, hatred, bigotry, and discrimination of any kind.

We require all patrons and staff to conform to the following code of conduct:

- Be courteous of everyone. We will not tolerate intentionally unruly or disruptive behavior, and we encourage everyone to report inappropriate or offensive behavior to theater management.
- Use of offensive language, obscene gestures, unwelcome verbal and physical sexual attention, fighting, throwing objects, and engaging in other behavior detrimental to the safety and enjoyment of everyone is prohibited. We reserve the right to refuse admission or eject any person whose conduct is deemed by management to be disorderly or who fails to comply with Montclair Film, The Clairidge, or The Bellevue personnel and any posted signs.
- Be respectful of the venue property.
- No outside food or drinks are permitted.

- Turn off cell phones or set them to silent mode and refrain from text messaging and using cell phones as a light source during a screening (except when using accessibility technology).
- Taking photographs and using recording devices is never permitted during any screenings.
- Smoking and vaping are not permitted within 25 feet of our buildings.
- MF occasionally takes photos in our spaces for marketing and communication purposes. If you do not want to be photographed please let the photographer or staff member know.
- Everyone, including law enforcement personnel not present in an official capacity, is prohibited from bringing weapons onto the premises. Weapons include, but are not limited to, firearms, explosives, stun guns, handcuffs, brass knuckles, sticks, clubs, batons, martial arts instruments, pepper spray, tear gas, knives, and glass items. Anyone found in possession of the above-mentioned items will be asked to leave without a refund. Montclair Film reserves the right to contact the authorities immediately for patrons who refuse to comply.
- Patrons who violate the Code of Conduct may be subject to ejection without a ticket refund.
